 Faith Formation registration for grades 1-12 is ongoing. Classes will begin in August. Grades 1-6 will meet on Tuesday evenings from 6:15pm - 7:30pm. Sacramental prep for First Communion begins with 1st Grade, Sacrament received in 2nd Grade or later. Confirmation begins with registration in 7th Grade, Sacrament conferred in 8th Grade or later. Youth Group will be held on two Sundays a month from 4:30pm - 6:00pm for grades 7-12. Registering your children now will help with planning for classroom space & the number of teachers/catechists needed. Parents, we need your help to make the program a success. There are many opportunities to teach, support and provide other help during the year. \$25 fee for one child per family; \$15 fee for each additional child per family.

Community Outreach Opportunities
Ashe Co. Pregnancy Center: The Center welcomes volunteers in several capacities: the Board of Directors has several vacancies at this time; indoor helpers to sort, clean, and arrange displays of donated baby-related items; and maintenance assistance outdoors other than mowing - the deck and gazebo need debris removed and cleaning so they can be used, weeding perennial flower beds, and similar tasks.
