Over the past few weeks we have had more incidences of the supports for the kneelers being broken off. This then requires the kneeler to be removed and the part to be replaced. Replacement parts are expensive (**about \$12 each**) so we ask that when you lift

the kneelers up to rest on the supports that you do so gently. As well, if resting feet on the raised kneeler please do not push against it. This puts pressure on those supports and can cause shearing off. Those with children are asked to please not allow your child to push on, or stand on the raised kneeler. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

The Natural Family Planning (NFP) program of Catholic Charities is continuing to provide online courses and plans to resume in person instruction in the New Year. Además, si descansa los pies sobre la rodillera levantada, por favor, no empuje contra ella. Esto ejerce presión sobre esos soportes y puede provocar que se quiebre.
