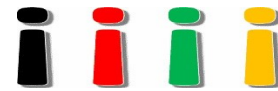

Eventos y uso de los edificios de la iglesia

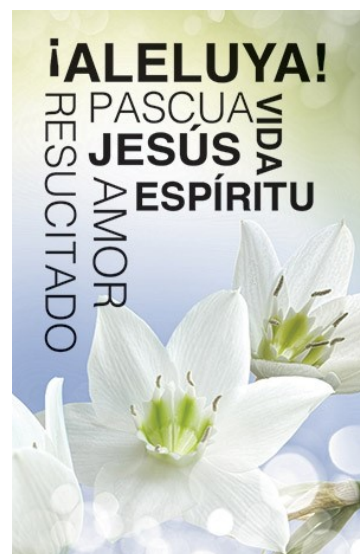
