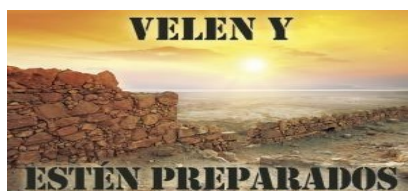

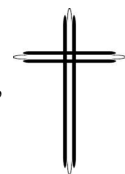

Volunteering in the church
St Francis of Assisi offers many opportunities to volunteer and share your time and talent. For those who wish to volunteer the Diocese of Charlotte requires the following documents and training to be completed: Acknowledgement of the Code of Ethics/Sexual Misconduct Policy, Background Check Release Form, Volunteer Profile Application and Virtus Protecting God's Children Training and monthly Continuing Education through bulletin inserts or online viewing.



This can be done in 2 ways:
1. A Volunteer Packet can be picked up from the church office. Completed paperwork is then returned to the office. Protecting God's Children Training for first time volunteers is being conducted online at virtusonline.org. The volunteer creates an account to take the training and has the option to either read the monthly bulletins online or read them when they are provided monthly in the church bulletin.
2. The volunteer goes online to virtusonline.org, creates an account and takes the Protecting God's Children Training. Once that is accomplished the above listed documentation can be completed online at the Virtus website. Monthly bulletins still are to be read online or through the ones provided by the church.
