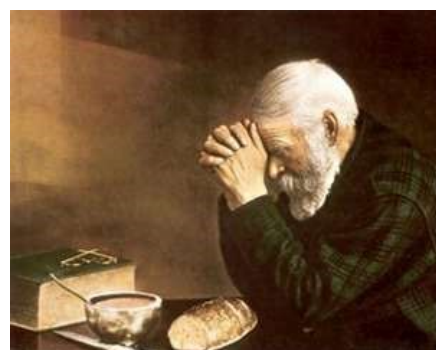
Proyectos navideños de San Francisco

Los regalos para el proyecto STAR para personas mayores / mayores deben presentarse antes del 4 de diciembre.

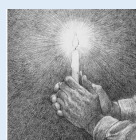

La oficina de la iglesia estará cerrada el lunes 21 de noviembre y jueves y viernes, 24 y 25 de noviembre.

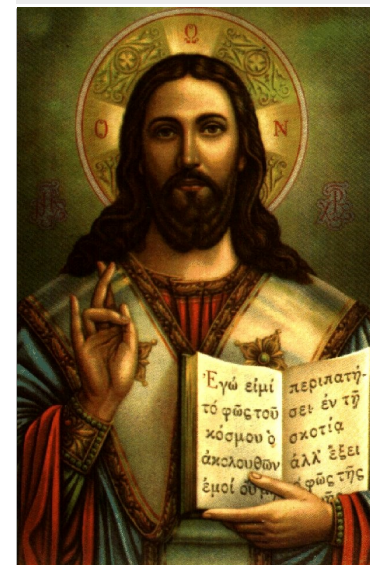
