Se recomienda encarecidamente a los voluntarios con cuentas virtus que visiten virtusonline.org para comprobar su estado. **Tenga en cuenta que aquellos que han completado la protección de los hijos de Dios (PGC) están obligados a mantenerse al día en las actualizaciones de capacitación virtus.** Para aquellos que no tienen correo electrónico la oficina pone a disposición una copia impresa mensual como un inserto en el boletín de la iglesia y en los tabloneros de anuncios ubicados en la esclusa de la planta baja. Debido a las restricciones covid sesiones de capacitación PGC, que sólo necesita ser tomado una vez, se ofrecen en línea para nuevos voluntarios. Una vez que el PGC se completa en línea, el voluntario puede entonces enviar una verificación de antecedentes también en línea. Para aquellos voluntarios que no tienen acceso en línea, los paquetes de voluntarios están disponibles a través de la oficina de la iglesia. La documentación completada se devuelve a la oficina. Después de que la verificación de antecedentes se borra a través de la diócesis, los voluntarios pueden servir en su ministerio. La oficina aprecia el trabajo duro y la entrega de tiempo y talento de nuestros voluntarios. Estar seguros de que la documentación y la complicidad son actuales nos ayuda a todos en nuestra misión de mantener a los niños y adultos vulnerables seguros. Gracias y Que Dios bendiga.

From Fr. Cory:
Adult Faith Formation:
 The adult faith formation series The History of the Sacred Liturgy as found in the documents of the Church began last week. This is a ten (possibly twelve) part series, starting with Sacred Scripture and the ancient Church, moving through the Patristic age and into the Middle Ages, then taking in the Council of Trent and the Counter-Reformation, and into the modern period. The documents presented will be provided ahead of time.

The schedule will be as during Lent, with adoration from 4:45pm -5:45pm, concluding with Vespers, and then the talk at 6:00pm. Talks will be livestreamed on YouTube to enable at-home participation; we will take questions from those at home via the live chat function.

The plan going forward for adult faith formation is to have a short-form series during Advent and Lent (three weeks during Advent, and six during Lent), and then longer form series in the summer and fall, of ten to twelve weeks apiece.

This past week the office took part in online Diocesan training for Virtus. Advances have been made in how volunteers are to complete the necessary paperwork and much of it can be done online. Those who have created accounts are able to see if they are compliant in their documentation and background checks, as well as see which monthly Virtus bulletins need to be read. Volunteers with Virtus accounts are strongly encouraged to visit virtusonline.org to check their status. **Please note that those who have completed Protecting God's Children (PGC) are required to stay current in Virtus training updates.** For those who do not have email the office makes available a hard copy monthly as an insert in the church bulletin and on the bulletin boards located in the downstairs airlock. Due to COVID restrictions PGC training sessions, which only needs to be taken once, are offered online for new volunteers. Once the PGC is completed online the volunteer can then submit a background check, also online. For those volunteers who do not have online access Volunteer Packets are available through the church office. Completed paperwork is returned to the office. *After the background check is cleared through the Diocese volunteers can then serve in their ministry.* The office appreciates the hard work and giving of time and talent from our volunteers. Being sure that documentation and compliancy is current helps us all in our mission to keep children and vulnerable adults safe. Thank you and God bless.
