La campaña de capital de la rectoría comienza el 3 y 4 de junio

Después de la venta de la antigua iglesia y la rectoría en el verano de 2022, la parroquia identificó una residencia existente en Jefferson que cumplía con todos los criterios diocesanos para servir como rectoría de reemplazo. La Diócesis determinó que el precio de venta de \$ 650,000 era competitivo, y la parroquia completó la compra en noviembre de 2022. El dinero de la venta de la antigua iglesia se utilizó como pago inicial y la Diócesis de Charlotte proporcionó un préstamo de \$ 515,000 para comprar la propiedad. La tasa de interés del préstamo es 0% (cero) durante 10 años. Los criterios del préstamo son que la parroquia emprenda una "Campaña de Capital". La parroquia ha desarrollado un plan integral para pagar la deuda de la nueva rectoría. Ese plan incluye: la "Campaña de Capital de la Rectoría" requerida por la Diócesis, Colectas Semanales para la rectoría, recaudaciones de fondos, el Programa Brown Bag, Ferias de Alimentos y otras actividades de recaudación de fondos. La "Campaña de Capital de la Rectoría" es la parte de nuestro plan integral que pide a los feligreses que completen tarjetas de compromiso comprometiéndose a proporcionar apoyo monetario regular para pagar el préstamo de la rectoría. Por favor, sea lo más generoso posible. Una vez más, la Diócesis requiere esta Campaña como condición de nuestro préstamo sin intereses. El Comité de Campaña Capital de la parroquia está pidiendo a todos los feligreses registrados que recojan sus sobres de información etiquetados de la Campaña Capital después de las Misas del 3 y 4 de junio y del 10 y 11 de junio. Complete la tarjeta de compromiso adjunta y devuélvala a la segunda colección del 10 y 11 de junio y del 17 y 18 de junio. 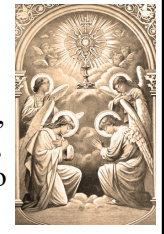

Rectory Capital Campaign Begins June 3rd & 4th

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

After the sale of the old church and rectory in the summer of 2022, the parish identified an existing residence in Jefferson that met all diocesan criteria to serve as a replacement rectory. The Diocese determined that the \$650,000 sale price was competitive, and the parish completed the purchase in November 2022. Money from the sale of the old church was used as a down-payment and the Diocese of Charlotte provided a loan of \$515,000 to purchase the property. The interest rate of the loan is 0% (zero) for 10 years. The criteria of the loan are that the parish undertake a "Capital Campaign". The parish has developed a comprehensive plan to pay off the debt on the new rectory. That plan includes: the "Rectory Capital Campaign" required by the Diocese, weekly Second Collections for the rectory, fundraisers, the Brown Bag Program, Food Fairs and other fundraising activities. The "Rectory Capital Campaign" is that part of our comprehensive plan that asks parishioners to complete pledge cards committing to providing regular monetary support to repay the rectory loan. Please be as generous as possible. Again, the Diocese requires this Campaign as a condition of our interest free loan. The parish Capital Campaign Committee is asking all registered parishioners to pick up their labeled Capital Campaign information envelopes after the Masses on June 3rd & 4th and June 10th & 11th. Please complete the enclosed pledge card and return it to the second collection June 10th & 11th and June 17th & 18th. Non-parishioners are also encouraged to pick up an information package and help support the parish. Your support is greatly appreciated.


PANCAKE DINNER/BREAKFAST


