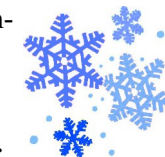

To register with the parish: Parish Registration forms are located in a labeled binder on the stand in the vestibule, as well as in the church office. Registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish and also provides an official record of your active membership. Being registered allows for participation in faith formation, parish programs and sacraments.

Currently registered parishioners: If there have been any changes recently to your family status, address, phone number, or if you have moved or will be moving please let the office know. This ensures the accuracy of the family roster and records on hand. You can drop by the office during business hours, or send an email to stfrancis@skybest.com after business hours. Thank you for your assistance.

Due to this WSOC will only be used for weather notifications when cancellation of all activities—functions and Mass—are necessary. A dispensation is given for those who cannot make Mass because of the road conditions in their area. **The advice throughout is safety first and to not travel if conditions are hazardous.**
