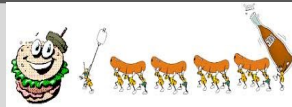

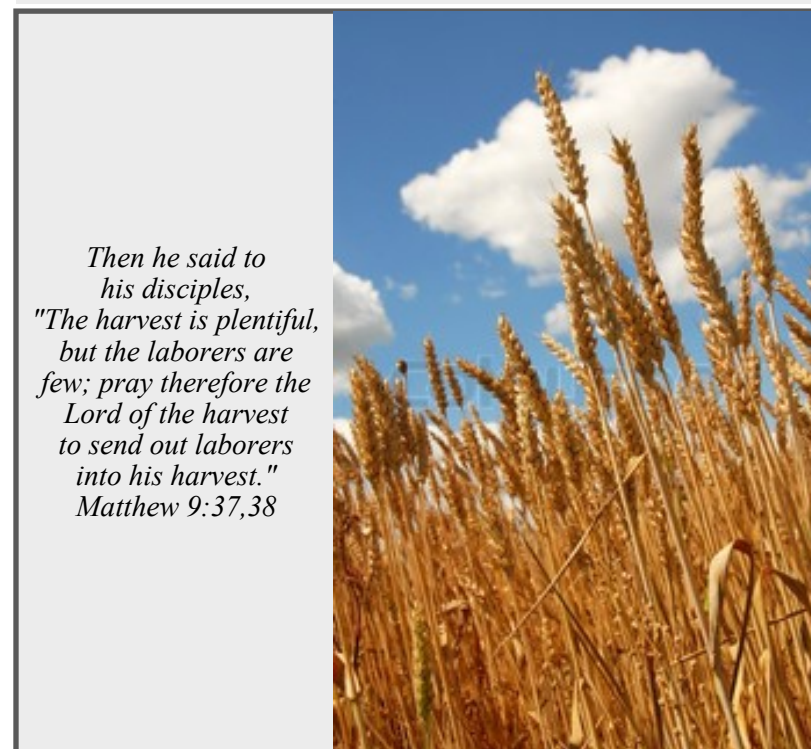

The next Parish Council Meeting is Tuesday, August 9th at 5:00pm, in the Fellowship Hall.

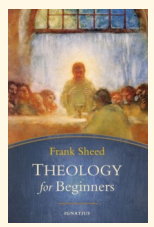
