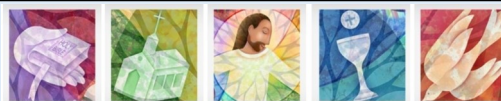

Se programarán nuevos voluntarios para servir en la parroquia una vez que se completen el papeleo y la capacitación.

Registro en la parroquia: Registrarse en la parroquia nos permite localizar a una familia / persona en la base de datos y registros de la iglesia. Faith Formation:

Registration is open for children in K-8th grade for Faith Formation. If your child is beginning preparation for either First Communion or Confirmation they need to be registered for class this year in order to receive the Sacrament in 2024. The Diocese requires 2 continuous years of Faith Formation in order to receive the Sacraments. Registration forms can be found in the Literature rack in the Church entrance or on the Lower Level on the Bulletin Board outside the FF Office. Return the form either in the Collection basket or in the Office mailbox in the Lower Level. Additional information will follow on date and time for classes.



The Knights of Columbus will be serving Bread and Soup each Friday during Lent (February 25 - March 31) following the Stations of the Cross. Stations will be prayed about 11:00am, after 9:00am Mass and 9:30am Adoration. All are invited to attend and enrich their Lenten journey with prayer, devotion and fellowship.

Help Wanted! The Liturgical Commission is still in need of Ushers, Sacristans and cleaners of church linens. Also needed are altar servers. If God is calling you to serve in one, or any of these liturgical minister roles, please contact Vickie at 336-877-5656.

For those who feel called to volunteer you can request a Volunteer Packet from the church office. Each packet contains a Volunteer Profile Form, Background check, Sexual Misconduct and Code of Ethics policies. Completed paperwork is turned in to the office for processing. As well, Father Cory asks that all volunteers complete Protecting God's Children training, even if there is minimal contact with children, to help keep everyone safe (children, adults, volunteers and employees). This training is available online at Virtusonline.org, where you will create an account. New volunteers will be scheduled for serving in the parish once paperwork and training are complete.

Background checks (BGC) for current volunteers are to be updated every 5 years. We have a few volunteers on file whose background checks have expired. Emails were sent out to those individuals last week, but if you are not sure if your background check is due please contact Chris in the church office. For those who have expired BGCs please update them as soon as possible to remain compliant and able to serve. Paper copies can be acquired from the office, or you may go online to your account on virtusonline.org and renew there. Your assistance is greatly appreciated!
