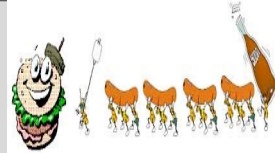

La semana pasada se enviaron notificaciones por correo a los voluntarios actuales que necesitan completar una nueva verificación de antecedentes. También se incluyó en el correo un formulario de verificación de antecedentes. A aquellos que deseen continuar siendo voluntarios se les pide que completen este formulario y lo devuelvan a la oficina de la iglesia lo antes posible para seguir cumpliendo y siendo elegibles para ser voluntarios. Las verificaciones de antecedentes también se pueden completar en línea en virtusonline.org. 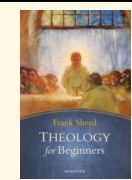
Time to Think about Christmas

 In accordance to Diocesan guidelines all volunteers are required to complete a background check every 5 years. Two weeks ago notifications were mailed out to current volunteers who are in need of completing a new background check. Also included in the mailing was a background check form. Those wishing to continue to volunteer are asked to complete this form and return it to the church office as soon as possible to remain compliant and eligible to volunteer. Background checks can also be completed online at virtusonline.org. We thank you for all that you do for the greater glory of God and for the St. Francis of Assisi parish family.
