

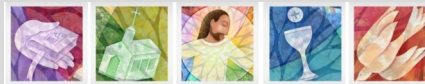

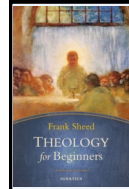

Faith Formation News
Registration is underway for the Fall classes. Forms are available in the Literature rack as well as on the Faith Formation Bulletin Board in the Lower Level. Please return these forms to the Office either during Office hours or in the Office mailbox on the Lower level. We need Catechists and Catechist helpers for Elementary students and Pre-Confirmation classes. Classes are designed to develop our children as knowledgeable and practicing Catholics. Classes will begin in September. The second half of Confirmation prep will start September 11. These classes are taught by Fr. Cory. If your child has not attended any formation in preparation for Confirmation, they will enter into Pre-Confirmation this Fall and will be confirmed in 2023. Children in 1st and 2nd Grade who have not had preparation for First Communion and First Reconciliation will begin classes in the Fall and receive the Sacraments in Spring 2023.

We are in need of a minimum of 8 volunteers to serve as Catechists and Catechist Assistants. If you have never served in this role, we will prepare you and guide you. All materials for classes are provided. For questions please contact Joanne Kuszaj at jkuszaj@gmail.com or at 336-982-3054.

Volunteers & background checks: In accordance to Diocesan guidelines all volunteers are required to complete a background check every 5 years. Those wishing to continue to volunteer are asked to complete this form and return it to the church office as soon as possible to remain compliant and eligible to volunteer. Background checks can also be completed online at virtusonline.org. We thank you for all that you do for the greater glory of God and for the St. Francis of Assisi parish family.

Silence please.... As we come to church to celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass please remember that we are entering a place deserving of *reverence and respect*. Once we enter the nave we are in the presence of Our Lord. At the conclusion of Mass we should continue to show that reverence until we leave the nave of the church. It is requested that all conversations be made in the vestibule or narthex, before entering and after leaving the nave. Any conversations that must be made in the nave should always be done quietly and out of the main aisle way. Many fellow parishioners spend time with the Lord in prayer before and after Mass.
