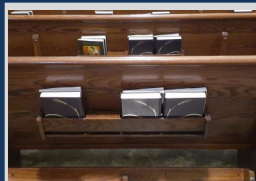
Noticias de Formación en la Fe:

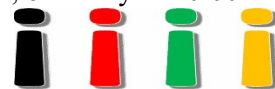

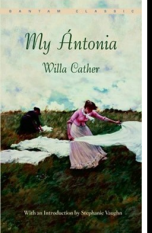
