Facilities Project Update
 Following is the status of recent work done with our facilities:

- *Cemetery Ditching Project* has been completed. Gravel laid across the drainage ditches now makes it easier for folks to visit their loved ones. Water diversion and drainage is also improved.
- *Cemetery Fence and Gates Project* has been approved by the Diocese and hopefully, once materials arrive, can begin in the coming weeks.
- The *Saint Francis of Assisi Painting* has been placed above the doors to look down upon the congregation. The painting will be framed by a local contractor.

For those who have not completed Protecting God's Children (PGC) training we ask that you do so as soon as possible. **This training is available online at Virtusonline.org.** **Father Cory asks that all volunteers complete this training, even if there is minimal contact with children, to help keep everyone safe (children, adults, volunteers and employees).**



In support of PGC training Virtus issues a new Protecting God's Children newsletter each month. All active volunteers are to read the monthly newsletters, which are to arrive in their email box, to stay compliant. For those who do not have an email address the church office provides these newsletters as a bulletin insert monthly. As well, background checks are to be renewed every 5 years. **For those who are coming due, or whose background check has expired, the office asks that you go to Virtusonline.org to submit an updated background check if you wish to continue active volunteering.** If in doubt of your status please contact the church office, or Amy Ankenbruck at the Diocesan Safe Environment office, 704-370-3357.
