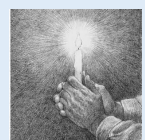

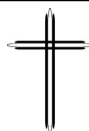

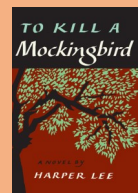


An All Souls' Day tile is located on the St. Francis of Assisi website for mobile and online giving. Names of deceased loved ones can be entered on the page when you give your donation.
