Cena de Acción de Gracias

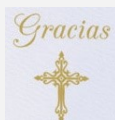

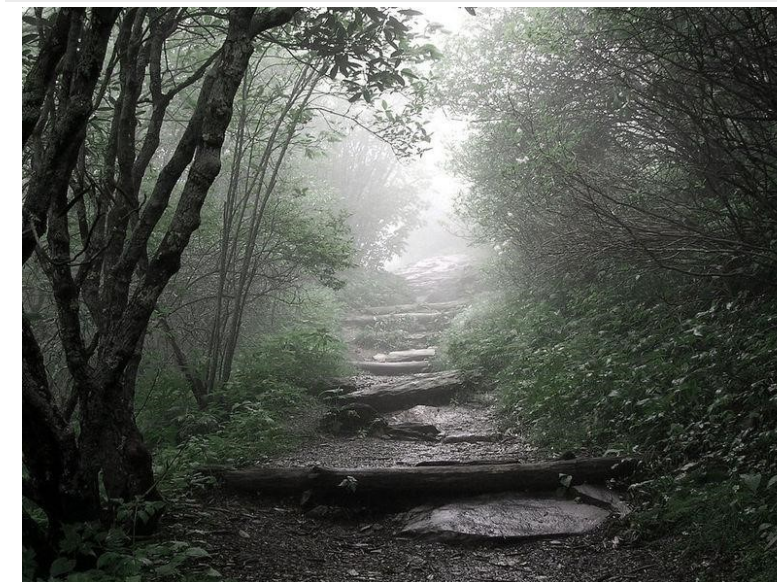
